Each student begins as one unit, then student groups with additional needs are awarded additional portions of units.</p>

 <p>Schools receive a specified number of Full Time Employees (FTE) for each position type based on the school-level ratios.</p>	 <p>Schools receive money based on the specific students enrolled and principals decide how the funds are allocated within the policies set by central administration.</p>

 <p>Funds are centralized to pay for substitutes, athletics and stipends, without regard to actual campus utilization of services.</p>	 <p>Principals adjust spending as necessary to balance student needs with financial responsibility.</p>
